

# AK Stamped Receiver Installation ACE Skeleton Folding Stock

I had an old ACE folding stock laying around from a project that never materialized.



I saw ACE was making a Receiver Block <http://riflestocks.com/store/product61.html>



# Step One

Remove The Bolt cover, recoil spring, gas piston, and bolt and you will see the stock is held in place by two screws



**Take the old stock out**



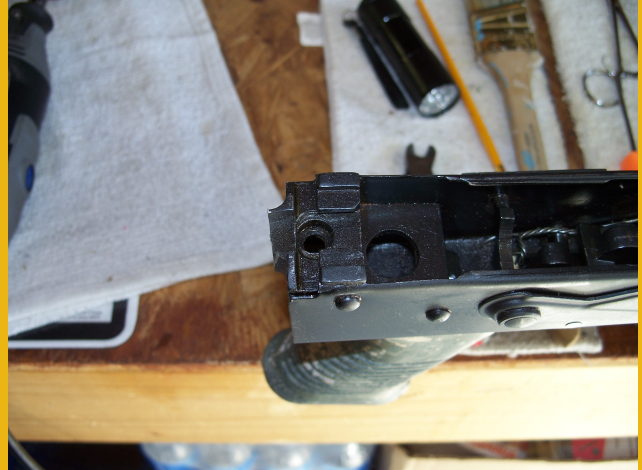


## Step Two

You now have to remove the rear tang on the AK's rear trunnion.  
I used my Dremel tool with a cutting wheel.



### **Rear Tang removed**



Now using a bench grinder, you need to grind the stub flush for proper fit of the Stock Receiver Block. I removed the pistol grip so it's easier to grip and handle while grinding the tang stub



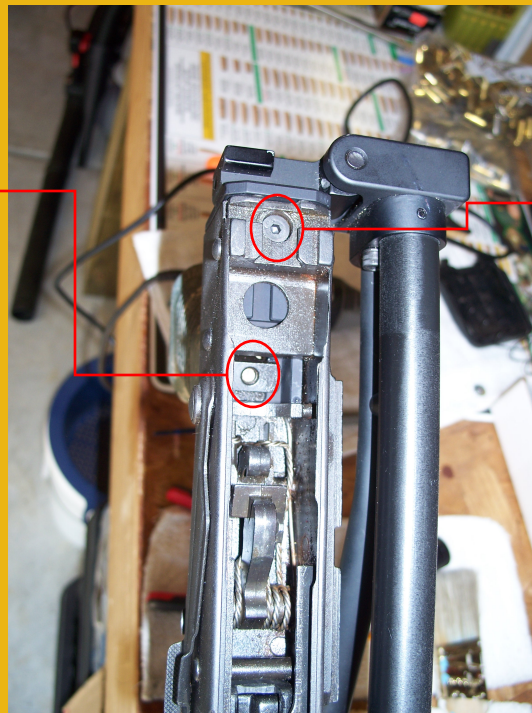
# Step Three

Once the Rear Tang is ground flat.  
Take the Receiver Block and insert the provided nut in the channel of the block.  
The block comes pre-threaded for your stock installation.



The Rear Receiver Block is held in place by the top screw and nut provided also using the pistol grip nut on the lower part of the block in the cut out slot.

# Final Step

Enjoy your new rifle stock  
Estimated cost is approximately \$210, install time 2 hours.



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
